She has also served as a keynote speaker and presented at scientific conferences and other programs. Through her work at the Tinina Q. Cade Foundation, she has hosted hundreds of education conferences for families sharing about different ways to become a parent and overcome infertility.

Dr. Hammond is the author of several books, including *The Guud Book: About Infertility*, and *The Guud Book about Faith and Fertility*. She is also the owner of the publishing house Guud Books about Tough Topics.

After an extraordinary medical journey gave Camille and her husband Jason, two boys and a girl, the couple decided to give back and help others still going through infertility. They started the Tinina Q Cade Foundation which, to date, has awarded 92 families with grants of up to \$10,000.




